

HLSCC Appoints Vice President

The Board of Governors at H. Lavity Stoutt Community College has appointed Dr. Anne Monroe as the institution's next Vice President. Dr. Monroe will take office on 2 March.

Dr. Monroe graduated from Central Michigan University in 1996 with a Bachelor of Science in Health Fitness in Preventative and Rehabilitation Services, and again in 1998 with a Master of Arts in Educational Administration and Community Leadership.

She went on to complete her Doctorate in Higher, Adult and Lifelong Education; Kinesiology Cognate from Michigan State University in 2004.

Before her appointment as Vice President, Dr. Monroe was Dean of Student Services at Northwestern Michigan College since 2006, prior to which she served as National Marketing Manager at Interlochen Centre for the Arts, also in Michigan.

Her higher education experience has included serving in various areas such as student admissions, customer services, academic advising and new student orientation, scholarships and financial aid, and health, recreation and wellness.

Dr. Monroe has also taught in the classroom and online throughout her career in areas such as health and fitness, organisational behaviour, and education.

Dr. Monroe has written and made many presentations in the area of higher education administration. Titles of her work include, Teaching the Millennial Generation, Non-traditional Transfer Student Attrition, Articulation Agreements: Not Just for Transfer Students, and Predicting Academic and Clinical Success from Admissions Criteria.

She is a member of several professional associations related to her areas of work and study and has served as Vice President of the Michigan Association of College Registrars and Admissions Officers. She has also been active in the community in organizations such as Rotary, Junior Achievement, and Sigma Sigma Sigma Sorority.
